***Application Process:**

1. Tryout Application (Online Form – See QR Codes on pg. 2)
2. Join SportsYou App - "CVHS Competition Cheer Tryouts 26-27" (Join Code: EPAC-4SKN)
3. Tryout Packet (Online Tryout Permission Form – See QR Codes on pg. 2)
4. Teacher Recommendation Forms (Need 2 teachers within the last 2 years – See QR Codes on pg. 2)
5. Passing 5 out of 6 classes (See below for more information on eligibility)
6. Rank One Account at 100% (See QR Codes on pg. 2 - All green and physical is current)
7. Currently enrolled as a student at CVHS or a feeder school

***More Information on Eligibility:**

*Cheerleaders' eligibility for tryouts is determined by the following:

- Grades from the Fall 2025 semester. Athletes must have passed 5 out of 6 classes. If there is any clarification needed, please contact Coach Miller in room 2404. If placed in the program, athletes must maintain passing 5 out of 6 classes from Spring 2026 to participate in the Fall of 2026.
- Rising middle schoolers are automatically eligible provided they live in district, attend Creekland MS and have passed all 8th grade requirements

***What Are We Looking For?**

At tryouts, coaches are evaluating more than just skills. We are looking for athletes who demonstrate strong work ethic, coachability, & a positive team-first mindset. Competition cheer requires commitment, resilience, & the ability to grow both individually & as a team.

***Key Qualities We are Looking For Include:**

- ***Coachability:** Athletes who listen, accept corrections, & apply feedback quickly/positively
- ***Effort & Attitude:** Giving full effort at all times, maintaining focus, & showing enthusiasm—even when challenged.
- ***Technical Skills:** Proper technique in jumps, tumbling, stunting, & motions
- ***Performance Quality:** Sharp motions, strong facials, confidence, energy, & the ability to perform under pressure.
- ***Athleticism & Body Control:** Strength, flexibility, coordination, & the ability to safely execute skills.
- ***Teamwork:** Respect for teammates & coaches, willingness to support others, & understanding that team success comes first.
- ***Consistency:** The ability to perform skills repeatedly with control & confidence.
- ***Leadership & Accountability:** Showing responsibility, maturity, & setting a positive example - regardless of role or position.

*Tryouts are an opportunity to show not only what you can do now—but how hard you are willing to work to improve! Please reference the GHSA Scoring Rubric to see legal GHSA skills & beginning, intermediate, & advanced level skills necessary for team scoring.

***Tryout Tips:**

- *Be on time & obtain your tryout number each day upon arriving. Make sure to wear the correct color each day!
- *NO jewelry of any kind – necklaces, rings, earrings, nose-rings, bracelets, belly-rings, etc.
- * Students are not allowed to participate with finger nails over GHSA regulation (No fake/acrylic nails)
- *Please be picked up on time each day of tryouts.
- *No Phones or the use of electronic devices during tryouts is prohibited.
- *Tryouts and practices are closed to all family and friends and will be enforced all season.
- *No one is guaranteed a spot on any team – even if you were on the team before.
- *Any conflicts with tryout dates should be discussed **prior** to the week of tryouts.
- **All decisions made by the coaches are final!*
